

Statement

At maturity, and especially in the final stages of mummification, I perceive new forms and structures whose bizarre presence attracts me almost magically. I am fascinated by the aesthetics of the morbid, which I translate into the balance of powerful gesture and dynamic color. My work is in the tradition of the memento mori - remember that you are mortal - but in contrast to Vanitas symbolism of the baroque, I am less concerned with the reference to the finiteness of all being, but rather the beauty of decay in the sense of an aestheticization.
